SPAY AND NEUTER AWARENESS MONTH AND WORLD SPAY DAY

WHEREAS: For centuries, domestic animals have provided companionship, unconditional

love, and loyalty to people around the world. Today, these companions share homes with millions of Americans, offering their guardians affection and an

improved sense of well-being; and

WHEREAS: The citizens of Georgia have a responsibility to spay and neuter their pets. These

procedures are beneficial to the overall health of companion animals, and they drastically reduce pet overpopulation, an issue that costs the United States more

than \$1 billion annually; and

WHEREAS: Each year, shelters are forced to euthanize thousands of healthy, adoptable cats

and dogs due to an inadequate number of responsible homes to care for such

companions; and

WHEREAS: Spaying and neutering also helps to reduce several health problems that can be

difficult or expensive to treat; and

WHEREAS: All of our domestic animals deserve loving homes and adequate care throughout

their lifetimes; now

THEREFORE: I, BRIAN P. KEMP, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim

February 2020 as SPAY AND NEUTER AWARENESS MONTH in Georgia

and further recognize February 25, 2020 as WORLD SPAY DAY.
