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House Bill 1049 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 27 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 nursing home administrators, so as to revise the composition of the State Board of Nursing
- 3 Home Administrators; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 4 purposes.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 27 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to nursing home
- 8 administrators, is amended by revising Code Section 43-27-2, relating to the creation of the
- 9 State Board of Nursing Home Administrators and its members, as follows:
- 10 "43-27-2.
- 11 (a) There is created the State Board of Long-Term Care Facility Administrators, which,
- on and after June 30, 2020 <u>2022</u>, shall consist of nine <u>eleven</u> members. The members of
- the board shall be appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate, as follows:
- 14 (1) Three Four members who are nursing home administrators in this state, at least one
- of whom shall represent nonproprietary nursing homes;

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16 (2) Three Four members, each of whom are either a personal care home administrator 17 or an assisted living community administrator; provided, however, that on and after July 18 1, 2021, all successor members appointed pursuant to this paragraph shall be either a 19 licensed personal care home administrator or a licensed assisted living community administrator; 20 21 (3) Two members of the public at large who are not personal care home administrators. 22 assisted living community administrators, or nursing home administrators or pecuniarily 23 interested in any personal care home, assisted living community, or nursing home, or 24 have any connection with the personal care home, assisted living community, or nursing 25 home industry whatsoever; and (4) One member who is a health care professional with at least a bachelor's degree, 26 27 experience in elder care, and knowledge in dementia care and who is not a personal care 28 home administrator, an assisted living community administrator, or a nursing home 29 administrator or pecuniarily interested in any personal care home, assisted living 30 community, or nursing home, or has any connection with the personal care home, assisted 31 living community, or nursing home industry whatsoever; and. 32 (b) The term for all members shall be three years from the date of appointment. A member 33 may be removed as provided in Code Section 43-1-17, including removal for failing to 34 attend three meetings in one calendar year. All vacancies shall be filled by the Governor 35 for the unexpired terms in accordance with the requirements for appointment to the vacant position." 36

38 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
