A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 14 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to 2 electrical contractors, plumbers, conditioned air contractors, low-voltage contractors, and 3 utility contractors, so as to prohibit certain advertisements related to plumbing; to provide 4 for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 Chapter 14 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to electrical 8 contractors, plumbers, conditioned air contractors, low-voltage contractors, and utility 9 contractors, is amended by revising subsection (b) of Code Section 43-14-8, relating to 10 licensing required for electrical, plumbing, or conditioned air contracting, businesses 11 conducted by partnerships, limited liability companies, and corporations, applications, and 12 review courses, as follows:

13 "(b)(1) No person shall engage in the business of plumbing as a master plumber unless
14 such person has a valid license from the Division of Master Plumbers and Journeyman
15 Plumbers.

- (2) No person shall engage in the business of plumbing as a journeyman plumber unless
 such person has a valid license from the Division of Master Plumbers and Journeyman
 Plumbers.
- 19 (3) A person who does not have a valid license from the Division of Master Plumbers
- 20 and Journeyman Plumbers shall be prohibited from advertising in any manner that such
- 21 person is in the business or profession of plumbing as a master plumber or journeyman
