A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Code Section 48-5-40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to definitions for property tax exemptions, so as to update the population bracket and census date for a certain property tax exemption for certain leased property; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.** 7 Code Section 48-5-40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to definitions for 8 property tax exemptions, is amended by revising subparagraph (L) of paragraph (3) as 9 follows: 10 "(L) In all counties having a population of not less than $\frac{23,500}{25,400}$ are more than 11 23,675 25,500, according to the United States decennial census of 2010 2020 or any 12 future such census, where the person who is the applicant holds real property subject 13 to a written lease; the applicant has held the property subject to such a lease for not less 14 than three years prior to the year for which application is made; and the applicant is the 15 owner of all improvements located on the real property;"
